


- With Sunil Samuel of Websulting listed as the business owner on all D.C. government paperwork, Lillian T. Copelin listed as the D.C. government COTR, and Lenia Cash signing contractors' timesheets, the conflict of interest between husband and wife Richard L. and Suja H. Strickland has remained under the radar for years..
- On December 16, 2008, a contract valued at approximately \$2.3 million was awarded directly to Criss, Inc. for IT support with the OPRS by Contracting Officer Joseph A. Giddis, with Lillian T. Copelin listed as the COTR.

- Although Lillian Copelin is listed as the official COTR on the 2008 Contract Award, Suja Strickland
 was the Program Manager for the Unified Payroll and Personnel System (UPPS), mentioned in the
 Contract, making Mrs. Strickland a direct government supervisor over Websulting, partially owned
 by Richard Strickland, as well as sub-contractor Criss, Inc., a company owned by her own husband.

- Publicly available documents, such as the <u>attached</u> "RFP-SOAR Interfaces" document clearly show both Suja Strickland and Lillian Copelin held joint responsibility over the UPPS computer system, with Suja Strickland being listed first as the primary stake-holder:





- Sunil Samuel, Richard Strickland, Suja Strickland, Lenia Cash, and Lillian Copelin are known to have been working together, on-site at the D.C. government in Suite 420 South of 441 4th Street NW (One Judiciary Square) in Washington, D.C. Records from D.C. Government's ID badging and electronic access control system which control all doors in 441 4th Street NW confirm all the listed individuals worked together and cannot deny knowledge of the on-going conflict of interest:
 - o In 2006, all five individuals were issued D.C. government electronic key cards having access to Suite 420 South of 441 4th Street NW. This information can be verified by contacting the **D.C. Protective Service Police**, Office of Property Management, which controls all electronic access for D.C. government buildings:
 - Suja Strickland, Electronic key card issue date: 03/10/2006 (DC Gov't PeopleSoft ID #00006231, Employment Start Date: March 3, 1980)
 - Richard Strickland, Electronic key card issue date: 03/10/2006
 - Lillian Copeland, Electronic key card issue date: 03/10/2006 (DC Gov't PeopleSoft ID #00024840, Employment Start Date: May 31, 2000)
 - **Lenia Cash**, Electronic key card issue date: 03/06/2006 (DC Gov't PeopleSoft ID #00000053, Employment Start Date: January 18, 2000)
 - Sunil Samuel, Electronic key card issue date: 05/23/2006
 - Suja H. Strickland was certainly aware of the on-going conflict of interest, as the D.C. government electronic key card access doors show her repeatedly using her electronic key card to access Suite 420 South of 441 4th Street NW on multiple occasions, including the following instances:

- Criss, Inc. was mentioned as a contractor charging exorbitant hourly bill rates in a 2005 report by the D.C. Office of the Inspector General regarding the Administrative Services Modernization Program (ASMP): http://oig.dc.gov/news/PDF/release/oig04-1-12ma.pdf
- Another possible relative of Richard Strickland appears to have been working for OCFO from 1997 through 2006: Lisa G. Strickland, Office of Finance & Treasury, OCFO; Home office - 441 4th Street NW, Washington, DC
- Richard Strickland may have been a full-time District government employee with OPRS before leaving the government to become a vendor to OPRS.

OTHER CONTRACTS OF CONCERN – D.C. Metropolitan Police Department:

Websulting, LLC appears to have found a friend in a COTR at the D.C. Metropolitan Police Department who, is *in no way part* of the D.C. Police IT department, yet oversees *all* IT projects within the Police Department. The COTR, **Anne Grant**, has an extensive history of multi-million dollar, open-ended projects that never deliver a final, usable solution, including Records Management System (Vendor: Intergraph), Records Management System (Vendor: Yellow House Associates), Juvenile Case Management System (Vendor: Yellow House Associates), Single Sign-on Portal (Vendor: Websulting, LLC), and many of others.

The COTR in question has been operating as a rogue individual for at least seven years, with the blessing of the Chief's office, spending money within the IT budget at will and often rewarding vendors of incomplete, shabby work products at the end of a contract with an additional government Purchase Order or grant finding and an additional "phase" in the project for completion and improvements. February of 2010, Websulting failed to complete their project at the close of the contract: Their punishment was the awarding of an additional \$399,468.20 in funding in August of 2010 for a 2nd phase of the project.
