

1. For convenience, the individual Commons each offers several Masses with all the elements, namely antiphons and prayers, included.

It is permitted for the Priest, as appropriate, to exchange antiphons and prayers of the same Common, choosing those texts which seem more suitable for pastoral reasons.

In addition, for Masses of Memorials, the Prayers over the Offerings and the Prayers after Communion may also be taken from the weekdays of the current liturgical time as well as from these Commons.

- 2. In the Common of Martyrs and in the Common of Holy Men and Women, all the prayers that are given for men may also be used for women, with the necessary change of gender.
- 3. In the individual Commons, texts in the singular may always be used for several Saints, with the necessary change to the plural. Similarly, texts in the plural may be used for an individual, with the necessary change to the singular.
- 4. Masses that are designated for specific times or circumstances should only be used for these.

COMMON OF THE DEDICATION OF A CHURCH






Prayer over the Offerings

COMMON OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

These Masses are also used for celebrating the Memorial of the Blessed Virgin Mary on Saturday, and in Votive Masses of the Blessed Virgin Mary. In all the prayers, where the word "commemoration" is found, "memorial" may also be used, as appropriate.

I. In Ordinary Time

These formularies may be used in accordance with the norms, even in Lent, should a celebration of the Blessed Virgin Mary occur that is duly inscribed in a proper calendar.

Entrance Antiphon Hail, Holy Mother, who gave birth to the King, who rules heaven and earth forever.

Collect

Grant, Lord God, that we, your servants, may rejoice in unfailing health of mind and body and through the glorious intercession of Blessed Mary ever-Virgin, may we be set free from present sorrow and come to enjoy eternal happiness. Through our Lord.

Prayer over the Offerings
Receive, O Lord, we ask, the prayers of your people
with the sacrificial offerings,
that, through the intercession of Blessed Mary,
the Mother of your Son,
no petition may go unanswered,

Or:

May the humanity of your Only Begotten Son, come, O Lord, to our aid, and may he, who at his birth from the Blessed Virgin did not diminish but consecrated her integrity, by taking from us now our wicked deeds, make our oblation acceptable to you. Thorugh Christ our Lord.

Having been made partakers of eternal redemption, we pray, O Lord, that we who commemorate the Mother of your Son may glory in the fullness of your grace and experience its continued increase for our salvation. Through Christ our Lord.

Having received the Sacrament of salvation and of faith, we humbly beseech you, O Lord, that we who devoutly honor the Blessed Virgin Mary may be worthy to share with her in the charity of heaven.

Receive, O Lord, the offerings of your people,
and grant that we who celebrate
your Son's work of boundless charity
may, through the example of the Blessed Virgin Mary,
be confirmed in love of you and of our neighbor.
Through Christ our Lord.

Communion Antiphon

Cf. Ps 86:3; Lk 1:49

Of you are told glorious things, O Virgin Mary, for he who is mighty has done great things for you.

Prayer after Communion
Grant to your Church, O Lord,
that, strengthened by the power of this Sacrament,
she may eagerly walk in the pathways of the Gospel,

O God, who, fulfilling the promise made to our Fathers, chose the Blessed Virgin Mary to become the Mother of the Savior, grant that we may follow her example, for her humility was pleasing to you and her obedience profitable to us.

Prayer over the Offerings
Accept, O Lord, these offerings,
and by your power change them
into the Sacrament of salvation,
in which, fulfilling the sacrifices of the Fathers,
is offered the true Lamb,

O God, who through the fruitful virginity of Blessed Mary bestowed on the human race the grace of eternal salvation, grant, we pray, that we may experience the intercession of her, through whom we were found worthy to receive the author of life, our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son. Who lives and reigns with you.

Or:

O God, who willed that your Word, begotten from all eternity, should come forth from the womb of the Blessed Virgin Mary, grant, we pray, through her intercession, that he may light up our darkness with the splendor of his presence, and from his fullness give us joy and peace.

Who lives and reigns with you.

Prayer over the Offerings

As we celebrate the blessed days which you made sacred by the Nativity of your Only Begotten Son, born into time as the offspring of the Virgin Mary, we pray, O Lord, that this oblation may sanctify us, and may grant us new birth in him. Who lives and reigns for ever and ever.

Communion Antiphon

Cf. Lk 11:27

Blessed is the womb of the Virgin Mary, which bore the Son of the eternal Father.

Prayer after Communion

Renewed by the Body and Blood of your incarnate Word, we pray, O Lord, that these divine mysteries, which we have joyfully received as we commemorate the Blessed Virgin Mary, may make us sharers for eternity in the divinity of your Son.

Prayer over the Offerings
Receive, holy Father, this offering of our humility, which we bring you with joy
as we commemorate the Blessed Virgin Mary, and grant, we pray, that it may be for us, who are joined to the sacrifice of Christ, our consolation on earth and our eternal salvation.
Through Christ our Lord.

Communion Antiphon Rejoice, O Virgin Mother, for Christ has risen from the tomb, alleluia.

It is you who have stood by me in my trials; and I confer a kingdom on you, says the Lord, that you may eat and drink at my table in my kingdom. Lk 22:28-30

Or:

See how rich is the Saints' reward from God; they died for Christ and will live for ever.

Prayer after Communion
O God, who in your holy Martyrs
have wonderfully made known the mystery of the Cross,
graciously grant
that, drawing strength from this sacrifice,
we may cling faithfully to Christ
and labor in the Church for the salvation of all.

These are they who come out of the great ordeal and have washed their robes in the blood of the Lamb. For God's sake they handed their bodies over for punishment, and they have earned unfading crowns.

Almighty ever-living God, who gave Saints N. and N. the grace of suffering for Christ, come, in your divine mercy, we pray, to the help of our own weakness, that as your Saints did not hesitate to die for your sake, we may live bravely in confessing you. Through our Lord.

Prayer over the Offerings

May the sacrifice soon to be consecrated be acceptable to you, O Lord, we pray, in commemoration of this precious martyrdom, so that it may cleanse our sins and commend to you the prayers of your servants. Through Christ our Lord.

Communion Antiphon

Cf. Jn 15:13

Greater love has no one

than to lay down his life for his friends, says the Lord.

Or:

Lk 12:4

I say to you, my friends:

Do not be afraid of those who kill the body.

Prayer after Communion

Grant us, O Lord, we pray, that being nourished by the Bread of heaven and made one Body in Christ, we may never be separated from his love and, after the example of your holy Martyrs N. and N., may bravely overcome all things for the sake of him who loved us.

Who lives and reigns for ever and ever.

Entrance Antiphon

Cf. Ps 36:39

From the LORD comes the salvation of the just; he is their stronghold in time of distress.

Prayer over the Offerings

We bring you sacrificial offerings, O Lord, to commemorate blessed N. and N., humbly entreating that, as you gave them the bright light of holy faith, so you may grant us pardon and peace. Through Christ our Lord.

Communion Antiphon

2 Cor 4:11

For the sake of Jesus we are given up to death, that the life of Jesus also may be revealed in our mortal flesh.

Or:

Mt 10:28

Do not be afraid of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul, says the Lord.

Prayer after Communion

Through this heavenly Sacrament, O Lord, grant us manifold grace on the celebration of the blessed Martyrs N. and N., that from so great a struggle we may learn to be united in unwavering patience and to exult in the victory they won for love of you. Through Christ our Lord.

Entrance Antiphon
The blood of the holy Martyrs

Or:

Cf. Wis 3:1-2, 3

The souls of the just are in the hand of God and no torment shall touch them.
