6. Conclusions:

In summary, of 420 documents disclosed to date, almost half (196) are either duplicates, produced by the Claimants solicitors or already on the public record. Of the remainder, all are redacted and 129 are heavily redacted, some so heavily that it is impossible to tell what the document is even about (see eg. FCO Schedule (File 1) served 10 Feb 2010, pg 27; 38-9; 265 and FCO Schedule (File 2) served 10 Feb 2010, pgs 83-4; 291-4; 309-311).

In other words, only 95 documents have been disclosed to date that are either not on the public record, duplicates or so heavily redacted they are almost useless.
